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Explanations

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1. If $x=3$, $y=-4$, and $z=2$, what is the value of $2x-y$?

To find the value of $(2x - y)$ when $(x = 3)$ and $(y = -4)$, we start by substituting the given values into the expression. First, calculate $(2x)$: $[2x = 2(3) = 6]$ Next, substitute the value of (y) : $[2x - y = 6 - (-4)]$ Subtracting a negative number is the same as adding its positive: $[6 - (-4) = 6 + 4 = 10]$ Thus, the value of $(2x - y)$ is 10. The mixed number $2 \frac{5}{8}$, for example, equates to approximately 2.

To find the value of the expression $xyz - 4z$ when $x = 3$, $y = -4$, and $z = 2$, we first need to calculate the product of x , y , and z . This adaptive approach serves two significant purposes: first, it helps in accurately assessing the student's proficiency, ensuring that the evaluation reflects their true abilities rather than a one-size-fits-all approach. Second, it keeps the student engaged, as they are likely to find the questions appropriately challenging, which can enhance their performance by reducing frustration and encouraging a focused mindset. In contrast, the other answer options do not accurately represent the adaptive mechanism of the Accuplacer. The test does not maintain a static difficulty level, nor does it solely rely on timed sections without flexibility or feedback, nor does it limit the experience by providing no feedback. Thus, the dynamic adjustment of question difficulty is what makes the Accuplacer uniquely effective for assessing student readiness.
