The question tests your knowledge of who currently holds the Midwestern Regional leadership in Alpha Phi Alpha's IMDP program. The correct pairing is Ronald D. Stovall II and Anthony J. Rucker. These two names appear together on the official Midwest Regional leadership roster, confirming they share the roles and responsibilities that oversee chapters in that region and act as primary contacts for regional activities and support. The other options bring together names that do not align with the official Midwest roster, either because they involve people from different regions or combinations not listed as Midwest officers. If you're studying, it helps to verify the latest regional rosters on the official site or in the latest IMDP materials, since leadership assignments can change with terms.

The complete title is The History of Alpha Phi Alpha: A Development in College Life, and it matches both parts exactly—the main title and the subtitle—so it is the precise official wording. The other options alter either the main title or the subtitle (for example, using different terms like Chronicles or Milestone, or omitting the colon and subtitle), so they don't reflect the official title. Knowing the precise phrasing helps with correct attribution and accurate citation.

3. Who was the last Jewel to be designated, and when did this occur?

Jewel designation is a special honorary recognition given by Alpha Phi Alpha at its General Conventions to members who have provided outstanding service to the fraternity. Eugene Kinckle Jones was designated a Jewel at the 38th General Convention in Cleveland, Ohio, in 1952. This event marks the most recent honor among the figures listed in the question, which is why it is the correct choice. Jones was a key early leader and organizer for the fraternity, helping shape its national structure and operations, which the Jewel designation honors.

4. The Phi Lambda Chapter is associated with which city?

Chapter locations are tied to specific cities, so knowing which city a chapter serves helps you identify it quickly. The Phi Lambda Chapter is the Raleigh, North Carolina chapter, so Raleigh is the correct match. The other cities—Durham, Greensboro, and Charlotte—are home to other Alpha Phi Alpha chapters, not the Phi Lambda one. Memorizing this city-to-chapter mapping, especially within North Carolina, makes it easier to recall during quizzes and discussions.

5. Which statement is true about Jamie R. Riley, Ph.D.?

The main idea is recognizing who sits at the top of the organization. The Executive Director and CEO is the highest leadership role, combining day-to-day management with overall strategic direction, oversight of operations, and public representation of the organization. Jamie R. Riley, Ph.D. holding that title means she leads the entire organization, not just a regional faction. In contrast, regional roles like Midwestern Region Vice President or Assistant Vice President are limited to that region, and the notion of having no leadership role contradicts the existence of a national executive leader. So, the statement that she is the Executive Director and CEO is the true one, reflecting the top-level leadership position.

This item asks you to identify who holds the General Treasurer position. The other individuals are known for different positions or roles within the organization and do not serve as the General Treasurer.

This question tests knowing the regional leadership structure of Alpha Phi Alpha and who holds the South Region Vice President role. Kelsey Rushing is listed as the South Region Vice President in the roster used for this practice, which is why that name is the correct choice. The other individuals are associated with different offices or regions, so they do not hold the South Region Vice President title.

9. When and where will the next General Convention be held?

You need to know the organization's announced convention schedule. The General Convention is a planned, multi-day event whose date and host city are established by the national organization and published in advance. The choice that matches the official upcoming schedule is Baltimore, Maryland, July 12-16, 2017, because it aligns with the published dates for the next convention at the time this item was created. The other options propose different cities and years that do not correspond to the next planned convention, so they don't fit the official schedule.

10. Who is the Midwestern Region Vice President?

A. Ronald D. Stovall II

B. Jamie R. Riley, Ph.D.

C. Anthony J. Rucker

D. Samuel L. Carter

The Midwestern Region Vice President is the regional leader who oversees the Midwest chapters, supports regional programs, and serves as a liaison between the chapters and the national organization. Ronald D. Stovall II holds that office, so this option matches the official leadership roster for the Midwestern Region. The other names are not listed as the Midwestern Region Vice President, as they hold different roles or belong to other regions.
