Additionally, Airplane Mode is another setting found in the Control Center. When enabled, Airplane Mode disables all wireless communications on the device, including cellular, Wi-Fi, and Bluetooth. This provides users with the ability to quickly toggle their connectivity options without navigating through the Settings app. While Safari and iCloud Drive are important apps and services, they do not have direct access points in the Control Center. Instead, they are managed through their respective app interfaces or the main Settings app. Hence, the correct options for accessing settings in the Control Center are Do Not Disturb and Airplane Mode.

Screen Time Settings are aimed at managing device usage and do not pertain to text and display customization.

While having too many options can sometimes lead to confusion or decision fatigue, it doesn't directly correlate with disappointment if the options available are presented effectively. Lastly, praising customers for their loyalty usually fosters goodwill and satisfaction, reinforcing positive feelings towards the brand. Therefore, failure to meet expectations is the primary factor leading to customer disappointment.
