Thus, understanding the timing and purpose of these legal instruments clarifies why Writ of Restitution does not belong.

The other drugs listed do not align with the common understanding of what angel dust refers to. Methamphetamine, heroin, and cocaine each have distinct effects and chemical structures that differ significantly from PCP. Meth is a powerful stimulant, heroin is an opioid, and cocaine is derived from the coca plant and primarily acts as a stimulant as well. Therefore, the identification of angel dust as PCP is accurate and reflects its established place in drug taxonomy.
