SAMPLE

1. Which promotions can the Appreciation Offer stack with?

- A. All promotions
- B. Premium PL
- C. Starter SL
- D. Switch and Tiered offer**

The concept being tested is how promotions can be combined, or stacked, with the Appreciation Offer. The Appreciation Offer is designed to be used together with certain other promotions, specifically those that are marked as stackable. The promotions that can be combined are the Switch promotion and the Tiered offer, because their terms allow stacking with the Appreciation Offer to maximize savings for eligible customers. Other promotions typically carry restrictions that prevent stacking, so they don't fit with the Appreciation Offer.

2. True or False: New lines have a full month of service billed in advance on the first bill they appear on?

- A. False
- B. True**
- C. Depends on plan
- D. Not billed until second bill

New lines start a new billing cycle, so the first bill after activation includes the full monthly service charge for that line billed in advance. This upfront charge ensures the line is paid for and service begins without delay, aligning the new line with the ongoing monthly billing schedule. While promos or device payments may appear separately, the base monthly access for the new line is billed for the upcoming month on the first bill.

3. What is the minimum age to be an AARP member?

- A. 16
- B. 21
- C. 18**
- D. 25

AARP membership is limited to adults who are fifty or older, since the organization focuses on issues important to people in later life and retirement. That fifty-year threshold explains why this is the minimum age to join. The options given (sixteen, twenty-one, eighteen, twenty-five) are all well under fifty, so they don't meet the eligibility rule. The idea to join at eighteen wouldn't align with how AARP defines its membership.

4. In the Android trade-in scenario, what is the value of the trade-in?

- A. \$45**
- B. \$30**
- C. \$60**
- D. \$50**

Trade-in value is the credit the program assigns to your device when you trade it in, based on the model and its condition. In this Android scenario, the device is valued at forty-five dollars, so you would receive a forty-five dollar trade-in credit toward your next purchase or your account, depending on the program's rules. The other amounts would correspond to different models or conditions, but for this case the listed value is forty-five dollars.

5. Which plan offers the most hotspot data?

- A. Premium PL**
- B. Starter SL**
- C. Extra EL**
- D. None**

The amount of hotspot data scales with the plan level, and the premium plan is the top tier among these options. That means it typically includes the largest hotspot data allowance, making it the best choice if you need the most hotspot data. The starter plan has the least, the extra plan offers more than starter but less than premium, and "none" isn't a plan you can choose for hotspot data. If you expect to rely heavily on tethering, the premium plan is the most suitable option.

6. When are customers charged sales tax on each phone ordered?

- A. On the date of order**
- B. With the monthly bill**
- C. At activation**
- D. When it ships from the AT&T warehouse**

Sales tax is charged when the device leaves the warehouse and is shipped to you. That moment marks the completion of the sale for the hardware, so the tax is calculated on the device price at shipment and appears on the shipment or first bill reflecting that shipment. It isn't charged when you place the order, nor as part of the monthly service bill, and it isn't charged at activation, since activation only enables service and the tax on the hardware is tied to the point of sale at shipment. The tax rate used is based on the ship-to address.

7. What is included in the premium data for Unlimited Premium PL?

A. Unlimited

B. 1GB

C. 5GB

D. 50GB

The key idea is that the plan described as Unlimited Premium PL includes data without a finite cap. The premium data here is unlimited, meaning there isn't a fixed amount like 1GB, 5GB, or 50GB included. The term "Unlimited" in the plan name signals that you get data without a preset limit, which is why that option best matches what's included. Finite amounts would contradict the plan's unlimited nature, which is why the other numbers don't fit.

8. How much hotspot is included with the Unlimited Premium PL plan?

A. 60GB

B. 30GB

C. 90GB

D. 10GB

Hotspot data allowance is being tested here. On the Unlimited Premium PL plan, you get 60GB of high-speed hotspot data per line per billing cycle. This means you can tether other devices and use data at normal hotspot speeds up to 60GB. Once you reach that amount, hotspot speeds are reduced for the rest of the cycle, so you're not cut off entirely but experience slower speeds. That's why 60GB is the correct included hotspot amount. The other numbers don't match what this plan offers.

9. What are the basics of Premium PL?

A. Unlimited data not slowed, 60GB hotspot data, unlimited talk in 200+ Latin American countries, Mexico, and Canada

B. Unlimited data but slows after 75GB, 30GB hotspot data, talk in Mexico and Canada

C. Unlimited data but slows quicker without priority, 5GB hotspot data, talk in Mexico and Canada

D. Data only for domestic use

Premium PL basics center on three main ideas: how data is handled, how much hotspot data you get, and international talk coverage. This plan offers unlimited data without any slowing due to usage, so your speeds don't get throttled as you use more data. It also includes a substantial 60GB of hotspot data for tethering devices. In addition, you get unlimited talking in Mexico, Canada, and 200+ Latin American countries, making international calling broadly useful. The combination of no data throttling, a generous hotspot allotment, and extensive international talk is what distinguishes this option from plans that throttle data after a certain point, offer much less hotspot data, or restrict usage to domestic numbers only.

10. What is the term for transferring a phone number from one carrier to AT&T?

A. Unlocking

B. Porting

C. Activation

D. Registration

Porting is the process of moving your existing phone number from another carrier to AT&T, so you can keep the same number on a new network. When you port in, AT&T handles the transfer from your current provider, and once the number is released, you're up and running on AT&T. This is different from unlocking a device (which relates to the phone itself), activation (setting up a new line), or registration (not the process of transferring a number). If you have the account number, PIN, and the number you want to port, the switch can usually complete within a few hours to a day.
