1. To minimize access for a contractor to manage an inventory application in Citrix Cloud, which permission should be granted to the contractor?

The key idea is least privilege with granular access. For a contractor who only needs to manage a single inventory application, you restrict permissions to exactly what's needed for that resource, rather than handing broad admin rights. Custom access in Citrix Cloud lets you define permissions scoped to specific resources (the inventory application, its delivery groups, related configurations, monitoring, etc.). This means the contractor can perform the required management tasks on that app without gaining access to other apps, settings, or the overall service. Granting broader roles like Cloud Administrator or Full Administrator would give wide-ranging control across the Citrix Cloud environment, which isn't necessary and increases risk. A Help Desk Administrator role is typically focused on user support tasks and doesn't provide the targeted app-management capabilities needed here. So, using custom access provides the precise, limited scope needed to minimize exposure while enabling the contractor to manage the inventory application.

2. To enable cross-domain use of the Receiver policy templates, where should you configure the ADMX and ADML templates?

Cross-domain use of policy templates is achieved by centralizing the policy definitions so every domain in the forest can access the same settings from a domain-level policy. ADMX files contain the actual policy definitions, while ADML files provide the localized text for those settings. Placing both ADMX and ADML templates in the Central Store (PolicyDefinitions) in the domain's SYSVOL allows you to configure the Receiver-related settings from a domain-level GPO that applies across all domains in the forest. This approach ensures consistent policy options everywhere and avoids local-only configurations. Using only locally stored templates or only one type (ADML or ADMX) would not provide the cross-domain reach or the complete, defined policy set.

3. Which type of certificate is typically used to enable secure client connections to StoreFront after provisioning?

Secure client connections to StoreFront rely on a server certificate installed on the StoreFront web server to enable HTTPS and to authenticate the server to clients. This certificate is what the client receives during the TLS handshake, proving the server's identity and enabling encryption for the session. For this to work smoothly, the certificate should be a server authentication certificate (EKU includes Server Authentication), issued by a trusted Certificate Authority, and bound to the StoreFront IIS site with a common name that matches the StoreFront URL. A client certificate is used for mutual authentication, where the client must present its own certificate to prove its identity. That's not the standard method used to secure StoreFront connections for typical deployments. Intermediate certificates are part of the trust chain and may be installed to help clients validate the server's certificate, but they are not the certificate presented to clients as the identity of the StoreFront server. Root certificates are trusted anchors in the client's store; they aren't used as the certificate the server presents during TLS. So the best choice is a server certificate, because it directly provides the TLS-secured channel and server identity required for StoreFront client access.

4. Which setting would ensure printer properties are retained on the client device only?

The setting being tested is saving printer properties on the client device only. By keeping printer properties in the local endpoint, the client stores and applies the printer configuration from its own cache, so the user's preferred defaults stay with that device across sessions. This avoids roaming the settings with the user profile or storing them on the server, which could lead to inconsistent behavior across devices or profiles. If printer properties are saved in the user profile, they roam with the user; if not retained at all, the user would lose their custom printer settings after logoff. Therefore, saving printer properties on the client device only is the correct choice for device-bound retention.

5. Which built-in delegated administration role is the minimum required to create an Application Group in Citrix Studio?

Creating an Application Group depends on managing the Delivery Group that contains it, since Application Groups are defined within Delivery Groups in Citrix Studio. The Delivery Group Administrator role specifically grants the rights to create and configure Delivery Groups and their associated Application Groups, so it's the minimum built-in delegated permission needed to perform this task. Other roles focus on different areas: Machine Catalog Administrator handles machine catalogs, Host Administrator deals with hosts, and Help Desk Administrator covers end-user tasks, not app delivery configuration. So the smallest role that allows you to create an Application Group is Delivery Group Administrator.

Seamless login and pre-launch on Windows are best achieved with the native Windows Citrix Workspace app because it provides full Windows integration and session control. This Windows client can leverage logon credentials from the domain, enabling Single Sign-On and bypassing repeated prompts, so users sign into Citrix without re-entering passwords. It also supports pre-launch, which starts a session in the background so published desktops and apps are ready as soon as the user connects, reducing wait times. Browser-based options—whether web/HTML5—run in a browser and don't offer the same depth of Windows integration or background pre-launch capabilities. The Universal Windows Platform app is a store-based option with different capabilities and isn't typically the preferred choice for traditional enterprise Windows deployments needing seamless SSO and pre-launch.

7. What is the minimum permission a Citrix Administrator can grant to an IT manager to access Citrix Studio?

Giving someone the Read Only Administrator role provides the smallest set of permissions that still lets them access Citrix Studio. This role allows sign-in and viewing of configuration, inventories, and status across the environment, but it prevents any changes, which is ideal for an IT manager who needs visibility without the ability to modify settings. The other roles grant hands-on control over specific areas—Delivery Groups, Machine Catalogs, or Hosts—so they involve more extensive privileges and are not the minimum needed for mere access and viewing.

8. In the restart schedule example, what is the exact name of the Windows Server OS group used?

- A. Win2016-ServerOS**

Recognize the exact naming pattern used for the Windows Server OS group. The restart schedule example uses a form where the Windows version tag comes first, followed by “-ServerOS.” This makes the correct name Win2016-ServerOS, since it matches the version prefix and the ServerOS descriptor in the exact order. The other options break this pattern: reversing the parts yields ServerOS-Win2016, which changes the order; using OSGroup changes the descriptor word; and combining into Win2016-ServerOSGroup adds an extra term that doesn’t match the shown label.

9. Which statement is true about Application Prelaunch and Session Sharing in terms of launch time improvements?

Both features improve launch times by tackling different parts of the startup process. Application Prelaunch runs a background instance of the published app before the user actually launches it, so when the user clicks, much of the loading work is already done, leading to a quicker start. Session Sharing reuses an existing Citrix session for subsequent app launches, avoiding the overhead of establishing a new session each time, which reduces the time needed to get to the app. Together, they shorten the perceived startup time, especially for users who launch multiple applications in one session.

10. Which type of certificate should a Citrix Administrator request so that a client endpoint can communicate with StoreFront over an encrypted connection?

A. Server

B. Client

C. Intermediate

D. Root

Securing communication with StoreFront over HTTPS requires a server certificate. This certificate is issued to the StoreFront server's domain (its FQDN) and is installed on the StoreFront machine to present during the TLS handshake. The client uses this server certificate to verify the server's identity and to establish an encrypted channel for all data exchanged. A client certificate would be used only if you were implementing mutual TLS, where the server also verifies the client's identity. That's not typical for standard StoreFront access, so it's not what's needed here. Root certificates are trusted anchors used to validate the server's certificate, and intermediate certificates are part of the trust chain; they're involved in establishing trust but are not the certificate you bind to the StoreFront service itself. So, the appropriate certificate to request-and-install on the StoreFront server to enable encrypted client communication is a server certificate.
