## **Explanations**

### 1. Which of the following is a Marine Corps core value?

- A. Integrity
- B. Honor, Courage and Commitment**
- C. Respect
- D. Loyalty

Marine Corps core values are three Fundamentals: Honor, Courage, and Commitment. These guide every action, decision, and relationship Marines uphold during training and in the field. The choice that lists all three together matches the official set Marines are taught to live by, making it the best choice. Integrity, Respect, and Loyalty are valuable qualities and are important in military life, but they are not the named trio of Marine Corps core values. Understanding the trio helps connect behavior to duty: Honor means doing what's right, even when it's hard; Courage is facing fear and danger; Commitment is steadfast dedication to the mission and to teammates.

### 2. What is the term Leatherneck?

- A. The leather neckpiece worn to protect the neck and keep the head erect (correct)**
- B. A leather helmet
- C. A leather belt
- D. A leather patch

Leatherneck comes from the distinctive neck protection used on early uniforms—the leather neckpiece (neckstock) that covered and protected the neck and helped keep the head up and aligned in the line of march and combat. Because the nickname arose from this protective collar, describing Leatherneck as the leather neckpiece worn to guard the neck and maintain an upright head position best captures the origin of the term. The other leather items—helmet, belt, patch—don't explain why the term was coined for Marines.

### 3. Who is the Commanding General of TECOM?

- A. General O'Neill
- B. General Flynn

The main idea here is knowing who leads TECOM, the high-level officer responsible for training and education within that command. Because leadership posts like this rotate over time, the correct answer depends on the specific time frame the material is referencing. In the context of this item, General Mullen is identified as the commanding general. That means, for the edition or source your question comes from, he was the officer assigned to oversee TECOM. The other names are notable generals who have led other commands or served in different roles, so they don't fit the post in that same period. To verify in general, check the official TECOM or the service branch's current/period-specific bios or rosters, since the assignment can change with rotations and promotions.

**4. Which rank is shown with one stripe and cross rifles?**

- A. Lance Corporal
- B. Corporal
- C. Private First Class**
- D. Private

Ranking by insignia uses stripes as rank markers and branch symbols like cross rifles to show the infantry. When you see a single stripe paired with the cross rifles, that combination corresponds to Private First Class. It sits above Private (which typically has no stripe) and below higher enlisted ranks, and the cross rifles identify the infantry branch. The other options do not match this exact insignia pattern, so the one-stripe-with-cross-rifles is best aligned with Private First Class.

**5. To whom should you pass on all orders you receive?**

- A. The Commanding Officer
- B. The Officer of the Day
- C. The sentry who relieves me**
- D. Any Officer present

When you're on guard, you pass on all orders to the person who will take over your post. This handover guarantees continuity—the relieving sentry knows exactly what you were told, what areas are under guard, and any special procedures—so nothing is missed or miscommunicated as the shift changes. It keeps the chain of command tight and makes the transition smooth and accountable. Passing to the commanding officer or to any officer present isn't how routine handovers work, and while the Officer of the Day may oversee things, the immediate successor is the one who must receive and carry out the orders.

**6. What colors are associated with the Marine Corps?**

- A. Blue and Gold
- B. Scarlet and Gold**
- C. Red and White
- D. Green and Silver

Scarlet and gold are the Marine Corps' official colors. Scarlet, a deep red, has long been tied to the unit's heritage and appears in banners, uniforms, and insignia, while gold represents excellence and achievement, seen in trim and emblems. This pairing distinguishes the Marines from other services—blue and gold is commonly associated with the Navy, and the other color combos aren't used to represent the Marine Corps.

**7. Which rank uses three diamonds insignia?**

- A. Cadet Captain
- B. Cadet Lieutenant Colonel**
- C. Cadet Colonel
- D. Cadet Major

Insignia use visual cues to show rank, and in this cadet officer system the number of diamond symbols on the insignia increases with seniority. Three diamonds indicate Cadet Lieutenant Colonel, which sits above Cadet Major and Cadet Captain and below Cadet Colonel. This aligns with the typical order where Lieutenant Colonel outranks Major and Captain but is below Colonel. The other ranks would have a different number of diamonds, so they don't match the three-diamond insignia.

**8. Which leadership trait is defined as the ability to consider all of the facts of a problem and make a correct decision?**

- A. Judgement**
- B. Justice
- C. Dependability
- D. Initiative

This item tests the ability to weigh all relevant information and make a sound choice. Judgement is about evaluating the facts, weighing evidence, considering alternatives and potential consequences, and then selecting the best course of action. It's what you use when you pause to assess a problem thoroughly rather than acting on impulse. Justice relates to fairness and moral rightness, not the process of choosing the correct decision. Dependability is about reliability and consistency in performance. Initiative is about taking action, often proactively, which can happen with or without full analysis. But when the emphasis is on considering all facts and arriving at a correct decision, judgement is the best fit.

**9. Which insignia corresponds to Cadet Lance Corporal?**

- A. 1 stripe, Lamp of Learning
- B. 2 stripes, Lamp of Learning**
- C. 1 disc
- D. 3 stripes, Lamp of Learning

Rank insignia use both the number of stripes and symbols to show position. Cadet Lance Corporal is represented by two stripes along with the Lamp of Learning emblem. The two stripes place it above entry-level ranks and below higher non-commissioned ranks in this cadet system, while the Lamp of Learning signals the learning/knowledge aspect of the role. The other options don't fit because one stripe with the lamp would indicate a lower rank, three stripes would indicate a higher rank, and a single disc isn't used to designate Lance Corporal in this insignia set.

**10. How many leadership traits are there?**

- A. 12
- B. 14**
- C. 10
- D. 15

Leadership traits are a collection of qualities that researchers and practitioners associate with effective leadership. In the framework used here, fourteen traits are identified as central attributes for leaders. This count aims to cover a broad range of important abilities while staying practical, including elements like clear communication, integrity, accountability, empathy, adaptability, decisiveness, strategic thinking, confidence, resilience, vision, collaboration, creativity, humility, and coaching. Because lists of leadership traits can vary by author or program, other sources may cite different numbers, but this particular set is what the question expects. Focusing on fourteen helps you connect the idea that leadership encompasses multiple interrelated qualities rather than a single trait.
