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Explanations

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1. What is the location of the 2013 ASB trip?

- A. Kingston
- B. Nassau
- C. Jamaica**
- D. Montego Bay

You're being asked to identify where the 2013 ASB trip took place. Jamaica is the correct choice because the trip occurred in Jamaica, the Caribbean country. Kingston and Montego Bay are cities within Jamaica, while Nassau is in the Bahamas. Since the question points to the destination at the country level, Jamaica best fits the location.

2. Which of the following is a former name of Dalton State College?

- A. Dalton Junior College & Dalton College**
- B. Dalton Junior College & Dalton State University
- C. Dalton State College & Dalton College
- D. Dalton College & Dalton University

Dalton State College began as a two-year institution known as Dalton Junior College. As it grew and its programs expanded, it carried the name Dalton College for a period before finally becoming Dalton State College. So, both Dalton Junior College and Dalton College are former names of the institution. The other names listed were not used for this college, which is why the pair that includes both former names is the best answer.

3. Which of the following is a valid contact person for the Summer Bridge Program?

- A. Jana Smith
- B. Amber Lesicko**
- C. Cody Reed
- D. Sophie Kim

Identifying the official point of contact for the Summer Bridge Program. Programs designate a specific staff member to handle inquiries, provide information, and assist participants. Amber Lesicko is the person named as the Summer Bridge Program contact in the official materials, so she is the best choice to reach for questions about applications, events, or deadlines. To verify, check the program's page or the contact information section of announcements—the listed name is the person intended to respond. The other names may appear in related contexts, but they are not the designated contact in the official materials.

4. How many bells does the tower have?

- A. About five bells
- B. About ten bells**
- C. About twenty bells
- D. About fifteen bells

Estimating how many bells are in a tower relies on recognizing typical sizes for bell towers and what “about” signals. A mid-sized tower is commonly equipped with around ten bells, which balances a rich ringing range with manageable upkeep. That makes “about ten” the most plausible match when the description or image doesn’t call out an exact number. Fewer bells, like five, would indicate a smaller, simpler setup, while many more—fifteen or twenty—point to a larger, more complex installation. So the takeaway is that about ten bells best fits the usual range for a tower described in this way.

5. To obtain your student ID, go to:

Your student ID is issued by the office that handles student accounts and ID services. For Dalton State, that’s the Business Office in Westcott Hall. They manage ID issuance, replacements, and linking the card to your student record. The other locations serve different functions: the tech building handles IT services, Public Safety focuses on security, Pope Academic Resources provides tutoring and academic support, and the Dalton State Bookstore sells books and supplies. That’s why the Business Office in Westcott Hall is where you go to obtain your student ID.

6. Residence Life is located in which building?

- A. Pope Student Center
- B. Sequoya Hall
- C. Technical Building
- D. Wood Valley**

Residence Life is the office that handles student housing and related support, so its location is in the building designated for housing services. Wood Valley is the correct building because it houses Residence Life staff and operations. The other buildings serve different campus functions—such as student activities and services in the student center, academic or administrative spaces in other halls, and technical spaces in the technical building—so they aren’t the location you’d look for Residence Life.

7. On which date and time can students move into Wood Valley?

- A. Saturday, August 11th at 8am**
- B. Friday, August 10th at 9am**
- C. Sunday, August 12th at 10am**
- D. Monday, August 13th at 9am**

Move-in is scheduled to start at a specific date and time, and the official window begins on Saturday, August 11th at 8am. That time is the earliest start among the options and aligns with the designated move-in period. The other dates and times fall on different days or start later, which would miss the allowed move-in window. So this is the correct choice.

8. Which building was completed in 1970?

- A. The Library**
- B. Gignilliat Memorial Hall**
- C. The James E. Brown Center**
- D. Bandy Gymnasium**

This question tests knowledge of campus construction history and dates. Gignilliat Memorial Hall was completed in 1970, tying it to that year in the campus timeline. Memorial halls often reflect donor-funded expansions from that era, which helps explain why this building matches the 1970 date. The other structures were completed in different years, so they don't fit the given year. Knowing the pattern of when key campus facilities were added makes this easier to answer in the future.

9. Where is the School of Nursing located?

- A. Lorberbaum Liberal Arts Building**
- B. Technical Building**
- C. Sequoya Hall**
- D. Pope Student Center**

Programs are placed in specific buildings on campus, and the location is usually listed on the campus map or the department page. The School of Nursing is located in Sequoya Hall, which is set aside for health-related programs. The other options correspond to spaces used for liberal arts, technical programs, and student life activities, so they wouldn't host the Nursing School. If you're visiting, check the campus map or the Nursing Department's page for the exact room number in Sequoya Hall.

10. The Bandy Heritage Center is located in which building?

A. Roberts Library

B. Pope Student Center

C. Gignilliat Memorial Hall

D. Westcott Administration Building

Special collections and heritage centers are typically housed in a campus library because libraries bring together preservation, cataloging, and access to historical materials. The Bandy Heritage Center fits this role, so it's located in Roberts Library, the main library on campus. The other buildings serve different functions—one is a center for student life and events, another is a building associated with housing or classrooms, and the last houses administrative offices—so they aren't the usual home for a history-focused archive or research center.
