When a group works together smoothly, the performance benefits in several clear ways: timing and movements stay in sync because everyone relies on shared cues, counted rhythms, and practiced spacing, so formations and transitions feel precise and cohesive. Teamwork also boosts safety, since team members monitor each other, spot potential hazards, and coordinate risky moves with proper support and communication, reducing the chance of missteps or injuries. Finally, a united team delivers a stronger audience impact—the energy, confidence, and polish come across as a seamless, compelling presentation that engages viewers more effectively. Since teamwork enhances synchronization, safety, and overall impact together, all of these outcomes improve with strong teamwork.

2. Who wears number 12 and is a wide receiver?

Jersey numbers help identify a player and, for wide receivers, numbers in the teens are common. In this roster, the wide receiver listed with the number 12 is Trinity Benson. That makes him the one wearing 12. The other names have different numbers—Tyrie Cleveland has 16, DaeSean Hamilton 17, and KJ Hamler 13—so they don't wear 12.

3. Who is listed as the President and CEO?

- A. Pat Bowlen

This question tests who holds the top business leadership in the Broncos organization. The President and Chief Executive Officer is the person who oversees the franchise's business operations and overall leadership. Joe Ellis held that role, serving as the Broncos' chief executive and coordinating with ownership and the league. Pat Bowlen was the owner, not the CEO; Vic Fangio is the head coach, focusing on on-field performance; and John Elway led football operations as president of football operations (and GM), a different leadership track from the CEO. So the listed President and CEO is Joe Ellis.

4. Retired numbers include which trio?

- A. 7, 18, 40
- B. 7, 18, 44**
- C. 18, 7, 44
- D. 7, 44, 18

Retiring a jersey number is a way teams honor players whose impact on the franchise is lasting enough that no future player wears that number. For the Broncos, the officially retired numbers are 7, 18, and 44. These three numbers symbolize players who defined significant eras in the team's history, and they are no longer available to future players. The other groupings include a number that isn't part of the Broncos' retired set, so they don't match the trio that the franchise has honored.

5. Which play is used to exchange possession when the offense punts the ball toward the defensive end?

- A. Kick Return
- B. Field Goal Attempt
- C. Punt**
- D. Kickoff

Punting is the play used to exchange possession when the offense sends the ball toward the defense on fourth down. A punt kicks the ball away from behind the line of scrimmage to push it downfield, hoping the receiving team can't advance it or will be tackled quickly, so the ball changes hands to the defense. This is different from a kickoff, which starts a half or after a score, and from a field goal attempt, which is meant to score points rather than transfer possession. A kick return describes the return by the receiving team after a kickoff (and in practice can also include returns after a punt, but the action that actually flips possession here is the punt itself).

6. Which division includes the New Orleans Saints?

- A. AFC South

Think about how the NFL is organized: teams are grouped into divisions within two conferences. The New Orleans Saints play in the National Football Conference (NFC), South division. That places them with other southern teams like the Atlanta Falcons, Carolina Panthers, and Tampa Bay Buccaneers. So the correct division is the NFC South. They aren't in the AFC South, the NFC East, or the AFC East, because those divisions are in the opposite conference or in different geographic groups. The Saints have been in the NFC South since the 2002 realignment, which explains their place in this division.

7. In the 2021 NFL season, how many home games did the team play?

- A. 9**
- B. 8
- C. 12
- D. 10

In a 17-game regular season, the home/away balance isn't perfectly even. The extra game is allocated through the scheduling formula so some teams end up with nine home games and eight away games, while others have eight home games and nine away. This team happened to have nine home games in 2021, so the number of home games played is nine.

Teamwork in Broncos Cheerleaders performances centers on synchronized execution, safety, and delivering a powerful visual to the audience. When the group trains together, timing and spacing become consistent, producing clean, sharp movements that hit in unison. Clear communication and trust allow dancers to respond to cues and maintain precise formations, which is essential for complex routines and transitions. Safety arises from coordinated movements in group stunts, lifts, and crowd-pleasing prop work; knowing where teammates are and anticipating their actions reduces the risk of injuries. The audience benefits from this cohesion through a polished, energetic, and compelling performance; the team seems larger and more controlled, which enhances storytelling and impact. This is why teamwork is essential: it integrates timing, safety, and audience engagement in one ongoing practice. Delays in cueing aren't the goal of teamwork—they're a sign that communication needs strengthening. It isn't unnecessary, and it certainly isn't only about costumes; teamwork touches on technique, safety, and overall presentation.

9. Which defensive end is listed with jersey number 93?

In football rosters, numbers often hint at a player's position, with many defensive ends wearing numbers in the 90s. The clue here is the jersey number 93 next to a defensive end's name. The only listed option showing that exact number is Dre'Mont Jones, so he fits the description perfectly. Shelby Harris is listed with a different number, P.J. Locke has a different number, and Isaiah Mack's number isn't provided, so they don't match the 93 designation.

10. Which etiquette rule regarding audience interaction during games is recommended?

Respectful audience conduct keeps the game's focus on the players and the performance. Cheering and supporting the team in a positive, appropriate way helps maintain energy without drawing attention away from what's happening on the field. It also shows consideration for the players' concentration and safety, and it creates a welcoming environment for everyone watching. Being loud to distract the players can disrupt their focus and isn't considered good etiquette, since it interferes with the game and performance. Asking players personal questions during the game is intrusive and unprofessional. Ignoring the crowd misses an opportunity to engage and support the team in a constructive, positive manner.
