1. Angora is a fiber goat breed.

Angora goats are classified by the product they're bred to produce, and their standout product is fiber, specifically mohair. The fleece from Angora goats is valued as a textile fiber for its luster and softness, making them a fiber goat breed rather than a meat or dairy breed. It's not a wool goat breed in the usual sense, since goats' primary fiber is mohair rather than sheep's wool, and this distinction reinforces why fiber is the correct category.

2. Which device operates as an electric dehorner?

- A. Dehorning Scoop or Spoon
- B. Electric Dehorner**

Electric dehorner works by applying heat to the horn buds as it removes the horn tissue, cauterizing the area to seal blood vessels and help prevent regrowth. This makes it the appropriate choice when the question asks for a device that operates as an electric dehorner. The other tools are manual or surgical: a dehorning scoop or spoon is used to gouge out horn tissue by hand, a Barnes dehorner is a manual cutting instrument that removes horn tissue, and a scalpel is a surgical blade used for precise cutting without heat. Using the electric dehorner provides a faster, cauterized result when used correctly on young calves.

3. Which breed is described as cream white with a motherly personality?

Coat color and temperament are the clues used to identify the breed. Piedmontese cattle are typically a pale cream to white color, lighter than the chestnut-gold or red tones of the other breeds listed. They're also noted for a calm, maternal disposition, which aligns with a "motherly" personality. In contrast, Gelbvieh are usually golden to reddish, Limousin range from light to darker golden-red, and Hereford are red with a white face. Put together, the cream-white color plus the documented gentle, motherly temperament points to Piedmontese as the best match.

4. The Greenhand Degree is earned in which year of high school membership?

The Greenhand Degree is the entry-level recognition for new FFA members, earned during the first year of high school membership. It marks the initial step in the FFA progression, awarded after students begin their agriculture education and meet the basic requirements of joining and participating. Because it specifically acknowledges the start of FFA membership, it belongs to the first year, not the second year, senior year, or after graduation.

5. Which statement best describes the purpose of a Plan of Activities within an FFA chapter?

At its heart, a Plan of Activities is a planning document that lays out what the FFA chapter intends to accomplish and the concrete steps to get there within a defined time frame. It frames goals for the year, assigns responsibilities, outlines specific actions or events, and sets timelines so members and leaders can coordinate their efforts and track progress. While budgeting is part of organizing activities, and scheduling meetings or compiling a roster might appear in related materials, these are only pieces. The plan as a whole provides a roadmap for the chapter's activities over the period and serves as a reference for evaluating what was done and what remains. That's why outlining goals and actions for a specific period best captures the purpose.

6. FFA Creed adopted in which year?

The main idea here is when the FFA formalized its Creed. The official Creed was adopted in 1930, during the first National FFA Convention. This moment established the Creed as a foundational statement of the organization's beliefs and purpose. The other dates don't correspond to the Creed's adoption, even though they might align with other milestones in FFA history. Restating, 1930 is the year the Creed became part of FFA's official framework.

7. In what year did the New Farmers merge with Future Farmers of America?

The main idea is knowing when the two organizations combined into one. The New Farmers of America and the Future Farmers of America merged in 1965 to form what is now the National FFA Organization. This unification happened during a period of desegregation in education, bringing together chapters that had previously operated separately for different student groups. Before 1965, they were separate groups; after 1965, they became one nationwide organization, expanding opportunities for all students in agriculture education. The other dates don't match the historical merger year.

8. The Greenhand Degree is earned in which year of high school membership?

The Greenhand Degree is earned in the first year of high school FFA membership. It recognizes a new member who has joined the program and completed the basic steps to get started—such as being enrolled in an agricultural education course and beginning a supervised agricultural experience, along with learning fundamental FFA knowledge (like the creed, motto, and song) and displaying good character. This early honor is meant to encourage active involvement right from the start and to set the foundation for earning higher degrees in subsequent years. It's not earned in later years or after graduation, since those paths correspond to more advanced degrees or alumni status.

An FFA Advisor's role centers on supervising and guiding the chapter, mentoring members, and ensuring compliance with policies. This leadership presence provides direction for meetings and activities, helps members develop personally and as a team, and ensures everything aligns with FFA guidelines and school rules. Tax records are typically handled by the chapter treasurer or school administration, not the advisor. The Creed and other ceremonial decisions are usually part of member-led traditions, and committee tasks are assigned by officers with the advisor offering guidance rather than issuing all assignments.

10. Which pairing is correct regarding FFA emblem symbolism?

A. Rising sun - progress

B. Plow - education

C. Eagle - unity

D. Lamp - light

In the FFA emblem, each symbol has a specific meaning, and the rising sun is defined as a symbol of progress—the start of a new day and forward movement in agriculture. The plow represents labor and tillage of the soil, not education. The ear of corn stands for unity among members and the agricultural community, and the owl symbolizes wisdom. So pairing the rising sun with progress fits the emblem's established meanings. The other options misattribute meanings: a plow is about work, unity comes from corn, and there is no lamp in the emblem.
