The reason this is the best choice is that it matches the term used in FFA programs for the yearly schedule of activities a chapter commits to pursuing. While officers lead and manage the organization and members participate as part of the broader community, the formal role of representing state interests at the convention rests with the delegates. Advisors provide guidance and support but don't cast votes on national policy.

So the November 30 date following the Fourth Convention is the deadline for remaining actively registered; other dates don't align with the convention-based membership calendar used to determine active status.
