This setup is foundational to ensuring that the Fiori applications can receive the necessary updates and notifications from the backend efficiently and reliably. While the other options involve necessary configurations—such as creating bgRFC destinations or assigning roles—they are not the initial and essential step required for establishing the notification structure. Registering the inbound destination ensures that all subsequent configurations will be built on a solid foundation, enabling proper message handling throughout the system.
