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Explanations

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1. Which term is a figure of speech substituting one term for another?

- A. Metonymy
- B. Irony
- C. Allegory

Metonymy is a figure of speech that substitutes one term for another because the two are closely related or connected. By using a related name or attribute to stand for the thing itself, we can talk about a whole concept with a related word. For example, saying "The White House issued a statement" uses the building as a stand-in for the people and administration inside it. That kind of substitution is exactly what metonymy describes. Irony involves saying the opposite of what is meant, which is a different device. Allegory is a full narrative that uses symbolic figures to convey deeper meanings, not a simple substitution. A figure of speech is a broad category, and metonymy is a specific one within that category.

Economics focuses on how societies allocate scarce resources to meet unlimited wants. Production is the process of turning inputs like labor, capital, and land into goods and services; consumption is the use of those goods and services by people; distribution concerns who gets the outputs and how they are allocated, often through markets and prices. Economics analyzes how these processes interact through price signals, supply and demand, and incentives to determine what is produced, how it is produced, and for whom. This helps explain patterns of resource use, pricing, and policy effects on production, distribution, and consumption. Geography, sociology, and political science study different questions—space and place, social behavior and institutions, and government and policy—rather than the moment-to-moment allocation of resources in an economy.

6. A person who speaks ill of others is known as the?

Speaking ill of others behind their backs is called backbiting, and a person who does this is a backbiter. The term specifically names someone who disparages others when they're not present, and it carries a strongly negative judgment about such behavior. The other options don't fit because they don't describe a person who badmouths others: Fortunato is a character's name, a narrator is someone who tells a story, and Green Pastures isn't a term for this behavior.

Authentic representation means a true, lived expression of what Filipinos value in everyday life. Broader terms like global competence cover a wider range of skills for operating globally, but cross-cultural awareness zeroes in on appreciating and understanding cultural values themselves. Monitoring progress and feedback mechanisms relate to tracking performance, not to cultural understanding.

Two-way interaction across cultural boundaries is best described by effective communication. Educational scholars refers to people who study education, and International Education Initiative points to a program or policy area rather than the act of exchanging messages across cultures.
