Limiting submissions to one entry could be a feature of Forms, but without the ability to gather detailed RSVP and participant information, it falls short of addressing the broader needs of event management. Therefore, being able to collect detailed RSVPs and participant information is what makes Google Forms a powerful tool for event registration.
