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Explanations

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1. A barricaded subject scenario should be coded as which dispatch code?

- A. 50B**
- B. 52
- C. 53
- D. 49

When a subject is barricaded, it signals a high-risk, on-scene situation that requires a specific level of response and coordination. In this dispatch coding system, the 50-series codes are used for high-priority on-scene incidents involving a person in crisis, and the suffix B marks a barricaded subject. Using this designation immediately communicates to all responding units that there is a barricaded individual, prompting the correct resources—perimeter setup, negotiation options, and tactical support—to be prepared and deployed as needed. Other codes in the 50-series cover different on-scene scenarios, but they do not convey the barricaded-subject condition, so they wouldn't signal the same level of risk or the need for specialized response.

2. What code would you use for an abandoned vehicle left in a parking lot?

- A. Abandoned Vehicle**
- B. Stolen Vehicle
- C. Reckless Driver
- D. Traffic Enforcement

Choosing the correct dispatch code for an unattended vehicle left in a parking lot means recognizing that the vehicle appears abandoned, not stolen or related to dangerous driving. An abandoned vehicle is one left for an extended period with no clear sign of the owner present, usually in a lot or similar area. This code signals responders to verify ownership and registration, determine if the vehicle should be removed or towed, and take steps to clear the area if it's a hazard or obstruction. It's not used for suspected theft (that would be a stolen vehicle), nor for reckless driving (which concerns the operator's behavior), and not for general traffic enforcement.

3. A report of an unsecured building should be coded as which dispatch code?

- A. 52S

In dispatch coding, a broad category covers building or property issues, and a subcategory identifies the exact condition of that building. An unsecured building is a property security concern that signals responders should verify doors, windows, and access to prevent theft or tampering. The correct option is the one that specifically conveys that the building is not secured, matching this exact condition. Other options correspond to different categories or describe other states of the building that don't reflect an unsecured status.

4. Which code corresponds to Recovered Property?

- A. 57
- B. 57R**
- C. 57F
- D. 58

In this dispatch coding system, a number followed by letters tells you the exact status of the event. The letter R after the number indicates that the property involved has been recovered. That makes this form the clear way to communicate Recovered Property, because it explicitly marks the status you're reporting. The plain number lacks that recovery designation, and a variant with F would point to a specific subtype (like a firearm) rather than generic recovered property. The other base code (without the R) signals a different category altogether. So the code with the R suffix is the one that correctly represents Recovered Property.

5. Which code is used when an animal must be transported?

- A. 45N
- B. 47D
- C. 45T**
- D. 45L

Codes use a number to group related situations and a letter to show the specific action requested. When an animal needs to be moved, the action letter is T, so the code becomes 45T. This signals responders to arrange transport for the animal to another location, such as a shelter or veterinary facility. The other endings don't indicate transport, so they wouldn't be used for moving the animal.

6. What is the code for Alarm Bank?

- A. 41C Alarm Commercial
- B. 41V Alarm/Vehicle
- C. 41B Alarm Bank**
- D. 43 Civil

Codes are built with a numeric category and a letter subcategory. The 41 block covers alarm-related calls, and the letter narrows to the exact type. Bank-specific alarms use the B subcategory, so Alarm Bank is coded as 41B. This differentiates it from Alarm Commercial (41C) and Alarm/Vehicle (41V), while Civil calls fall under a different category (43). Understanding this structure helps you quickly identify the incident type from the code and anticipate the appropriate response.

7. Which registry would be consulted for information about individuals registered for sex offenses?

- A. Criminal Registration
- B. Test Call 911

- D. Sex Offender Registration**

The key idea is knowing where official information about people who must register for sex offenses is kept. That responsibility lies with the Sex Offender Registration. This registry is the dedicated database that tracks individuals convicted of sex crimes and provides their registration details to law enforcement and other authorities for safety and enforcement purposes. In Florida, for example, it's maintained by the state's criminal justice agencies and is publicly accessible in many cases. Because it is specifically designed to hold and provide information on sex offenders, it's the appropriate source to consult. The other options aren't registries for sex offenses and wouldn't reliably give the official offender information.

8. Which code corresponds to Weather Event?

- A. 55
- B. 62
- C. 60**
- D. 57

In dispatch coding, weather-related calls are tagged with a specific numeric code so responders can quickly recognize and prioritize them. In this set, the Weather Event category is assigned 60. So when a call involves weather conditions or hazards, 60 is used to flag it as weather-related, guiding units and coordination accordingly. The other numbers represent different incident types, so they wouldn't accurately indicate a weather event.

9. Code 10R indicates which event?

- A. Missing Juvenile
- B. Stolen Vehicle
- C. Recovered Stolen Vehicle**
- D. Abandoned Vehicle

Code 10R signals that a vehicle reported stolen has been recovered. The R stands for Recovered, letting units know that the stolen status is resolved and the vehicle is back in inventory. This is different from a missing juvenile, which concerns a person, not a vehicle; and different from the original stolen vehicle call or an abandoned vehicle, which involves other situations. In practice, when officers locate the stolen car, dispatch uses this code to indicate the recovery to all nearby units.

10. A watercraft operator is driving recklessly near the shoreline, endangering others.

- A. Drowning
- B. Bomb Explosion
- C. Narcotics Case

D. Reckless Watercraft

The situation centers on dangerous behavior by a watercraft operator. When someone is driving a boat or similar vessel in a reckless way near shore and putting others at risk, the appropriate dispatch category is Reckless Watercraft because it directly describes the unsafe operation of a water vehicle and the threat it poses. Drowning would be about someone in the water needing rescue, which is a possible outcome but not the action being described. The other two options—bomb explosion and narcotics case—don't relate to how the watercraft is being operated or the immediate risk created. So, naming the incident as Reckless Watercraft best matches the behavior and context given.
