Providing balanced context helps visitors understand complexity, wrestle with differing interpretations, and leave with a deeper, more thoughtful appreciation of the heritage. Rumors and sensational stories tend to mislead and can create a distorted or oversimplified narrative. Focusing on a single perspective ignores the richness of history and silences those whose experiences may differ from the dominant storyline. Withholding information to avoid controversy prevents people from engaging with the truth and disrespects the people connected to the site. A respectful presentation avoids these pitfalls by embracing accuracy, inclusivity, and transparency.
