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## **Explanations**

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### 1. How many Torch Categories are there?

This combination of community-building tools makes it the primary BPA social media hub. The other options serve different purposes: Yelp is focused on user reviews of businesses, Snapchat is mainly private, ephemeral messaging, and Tumblr is a blogging and content-sharing platform. Therefore, Facebook is the BPA social media platform.

The torch represents guiding light toward meaningful, worthy aims. The flame stands for motivation, inspiration, and a sense of moral purpose that drives us to pursue noble objectives. In this context, it isn't just about knowing things, showing courage in a moment, or leading others—it's about choosing goals that are worthy of effort and letting that purpose steer what we do.

**4. Which GPA requirement applies to Secondary Division Executive Council candidates?**

For the Secondary Division Executive Council, eligibility includes a minimum cumulative GPA on a 4.0 scale. The minimum is two point seven five, which ensures candidates meet a basic level of academic performance while taking on leadership responsibilities. This threshold provides a clear, attainable standard that still emphasizes academic commitment without being overly strict. A higher minimum would not align with the stated rule, while a claim of no GPA requirement would ignore the established criterion. It's also incorrect to say that GPA only matters for Post-Secondary, since the Secondary Division uses this GPA floor as part of its eligibility.

Owning the National Center represents a milestone where the organization moves from renting to having its own facility, signaling growth and stability. In 1982, BPA purchased the National Center, making it a true owned asset rather than a leased space, which is why this option fits the year and action described. The other possibilities would imply different kinds of events—establishing the center would mean it came into existence then, which isn't the event described; paying off a mortgage would come after a purchase and isn't specified as the action in that year; and changing a pledge refers to donor commitments, not the ownership of a building.

The idea being tested is when people first recognized a need for a national student organization to support business education students. In the early 1960s, as business programs grew and students wanted more leadership and professional development opportunities, educators and student leaders saw value in having a formal group to provide structure, competitions, and resources. In 1963 that recognition became clear enough to start planning a national organization, marking the moment the need was acknowledged. Later years reflect the steps of forming, organizing, and expanding the group, not the initial realization itself.

**7. What does the term 'business' mean in BPA?**

In BPA, the term business means the field of work and study for which members are prepared. It signals the broad world of professional activities—planning, communication, management, finance, technology—in which members apply efficient, ethical practices in a wide range of settings, not just in an office. This aligns with BPA’s mission to prepare students for business and information technology careers through competitions, leadership, and real-world projects. Software is just a tool used within business settings, not the concept itself. A department is a specific part of an organization, which is too narrow. A legal entity is a formal business structure, also too narrow. The idea here is the overall domain and range of business activities BPA aims to prepare students for.

**8. How many individuals are on the Kansas BPA Board of Directors?**

There are six members on the Kansas BPA Board of Directors. This size provides enough voices to represent different parts of the organization while keeping discussions manageable and decisions timely. A smaller board might miss important viewpoints or areas of expertise, while a larger board can slow things down and make coordination more difficult. Six hits a balance between diverse input and efficient governance, which is why that count fits best.

**9. Which of the following is one of the four points on the BPA shield?**

- A. Poise**
- B. Initiative**
- C. Fairness**
- D. Courage**

Poise, meaning staying calm, confident, and respectful in all situations, is one of the four points highlighted by the BPA shield. This trait helps members present ideas clearly, handle questions under pressure, and project credibility during competitions and professional interactions. While initiative, fairness, and courage are valuable qualities in many contexts, they aren’t the points named on the BPA shield.

**10. When was the National Center established?**

**A. 1971**

The main idea here is knowing the year a center officially began its existence. An establishment date comes from founding documents or the organization's official history and marks when it first started operating. For the National Center, records indicate it was established in 1971, meaning that is the year the center was created and began its work. The other years reflect later changes, expansions, or reorganizations, not the original founding year. If you want to confirm, check the center's founding act or its official history where the establishment year is stated.
