1. Which of these is considered a 'deadly weapon' under Kentucky law?

In Kentucky, a "deadly weapon" is defined as an object that is capable of causing death or serious physical injury. While items like a pocketknife with a small blade, a plastic BB gun, and pepper spray may cause some harm, they are not typically classified as deadly weapons under the law unless used in a particular manner or circumstance. A baseball bat, on the other hand, is generally considered a deadly weapon due to its potential to cause serious harm or even death when used in a threatening or violent manner. Therefore, a baseball bat is the correct choice as it fits the definition of a deadly weapon under Kentucky law.
