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Explanations

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1. What is the minimum age to apply for a CCDW license in Kentucky?

- A. 18 years old
- B. 21 years old**

In Kentucky, the minimum age to apply for a CCDW (Concealed Carry Deadly Weapons) license is 21 years old. However, a felony conviction would disqualify an individual from receiving a CCDW permit, as it automatically prohibits the possession of a firearm. Traffic violations, political protest participation, and past due child support would not necessarily disqualify an individual from receiving a CCDW permit, as long as the individual meets all other eligibility requirements.
