Planning, executing, and reporting are crucial for project management and operational execution but do not fully capture the relational and influence-driven nature of leadership. Finally, coaching, mentoring, and networking also represent vital skills for leaders but are more focused on support and personal development rather than the broader strategic dimensions of leadership, such as influencing and improving organizational culture.
