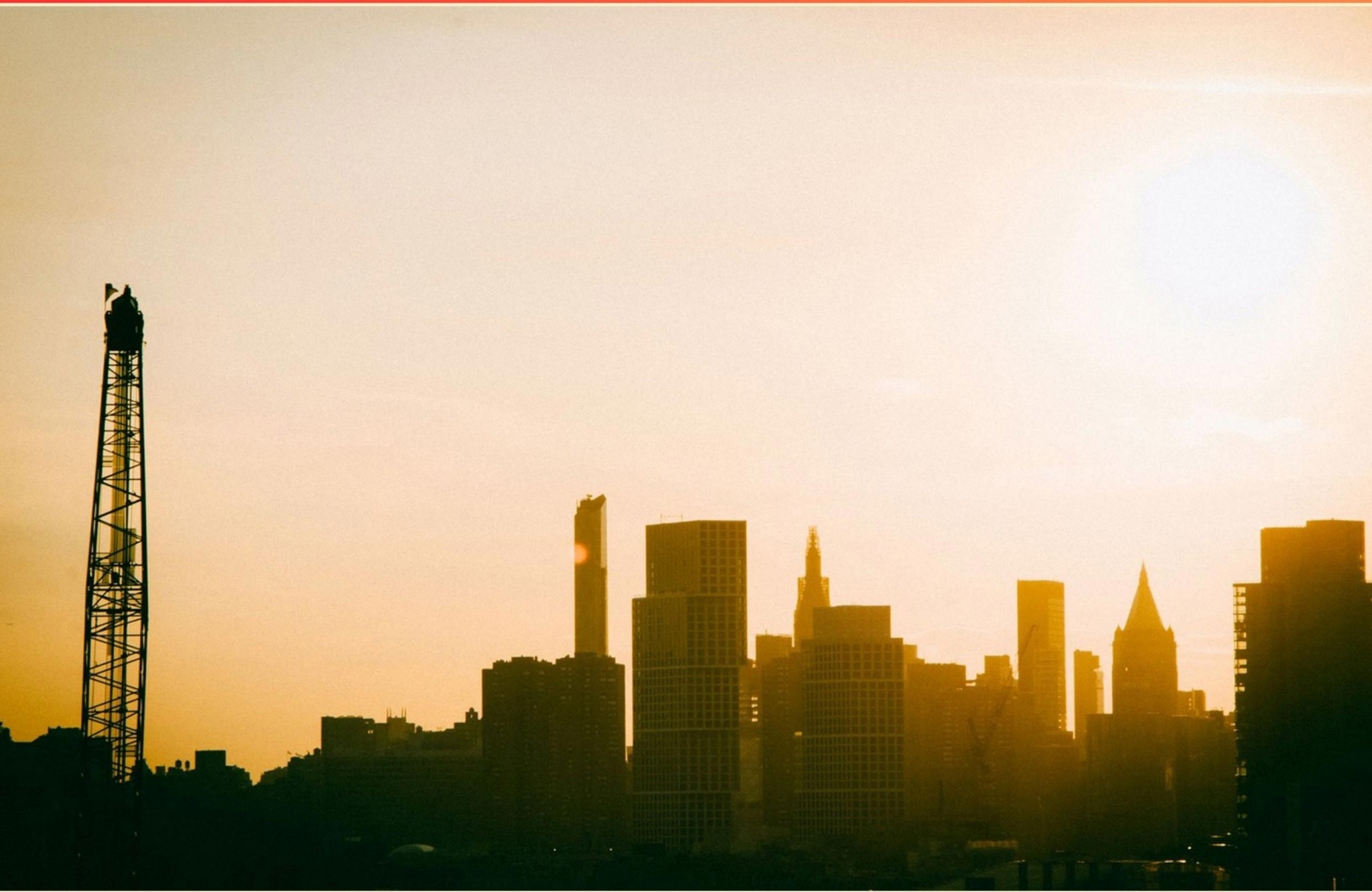

Roller setting is a viable technique to add curls, particularly for temporary styles, but it often requires more time and is not as enduring as a permanent wave, making it less effective for long-lasting curls. Thus, for someone seeking long-term results, permanents stand out as the most effective method for achieving curls.
