## **Explanations**

**1. Which station houses the Technical Rescue Team?**

- A. Station 14 - 1460 Norview Ave.
- B. Station 9 - 115 Thole St.
- C. Station 8 - 526 Frederick St.**
- D. Station 4 - 5909 Poplar Hall Drive

The Technical Rescue Team lives at the station that carries the heavy rescue gear and the specialized crew ready for high-angle, rope, confined-space, water, and other complex rescues. This team needs a station equipped with the rescue rig and the trained personnel to handle such incidents, so it's based where those resources are kept. In this department, that station is the one at 526 Frederick Street, which houses the technical rescue apparatus and crew. The other stations focus on standard engine, ladder, or EMS units and don't host the dedicated technical rescue resources, so they aren't the home for this team.

**2. Which address is assigned to Station 7?**

- A. Station 9 - 115 Thole St
- B. Station 7 - 1211 W 43rd St**
- C. Station 14 - 1460 Norview Ave
- D. Station 4 - 5909 Poplar Hall Drive

Matching station numbers to their street addresses helps responders and the public quickly identify where a station is located and how to navigate to it. Each station has a unique address used on dispatch messages and maps. For Station 7, the official address is 1211 W 43rd St. This is the address associated with Station 7 in the Norfolk Fire Rescue roster. The other addresses belong to different stations: 115 Thole St is Station 9, 1460 Norview Ave is Station 14, and 5909 Poplar Hall Drive is Station 4. So the address tied to Station 7 is 1211 W 43rd St.

**3. The address 2501 \_\_\_\_\_ Street corresponds to which street name?**

- A. St. Pauls

The street name is determined by the numbering pattern used on each street. In this set of questions, the 2501 block is assigned to Church Street, so the correct fill is Church. The other street names have different numbering ranges in the same city grid, so they wouldn't match the 2501 block in this context.

**4. Which station is located at 526 Frederick St.?**

- A. Station 1
- B. Station 8**
- C. Station 9
- D. Station 10

This question tests your ability to map a street address to the station that serves that location using the department's directory or map. 526 Frederick St is the listed location for Station 8, so that station is the correct match. The other stations have different addresses in the roster, which is why they don't fit this address. In study drills, get familiar with the station directory or map so you can quickly connect streets to their corresponding stations.

**5. What word completes the address 7924 \_\_\_\_\_ Road?**

- A. Camellia**
- B. Magnolia
- C. Birch
- D. Cedar

Street names for roads often come from nature and are chosen to be distinctive and easy to say. Camellia fits that pattern well: it's a floral name that's commonly used for residential street labels and sounds natural when paired with Road after a number like 7924. The other options are valid plant or tree names, but they're less distinctive in this particular address-style context—Birch and Cedar are very common tree names, and Magnolia, while familiar, can be used in different naming contexts. So Camellia is the most natural, widely recognized choice for completing 7924 \_\_\_\_\_ Road.

**6. Which pairing correctly matches an HRFA position to the person?**

- A. HRFA Lead Instructor — Lieutenant Phillip Gale
- B. HRFA Assistant Instructor — Battalion Chief Stephanie Lenhart
- C. HRFA Director — FF/Advanced EMT Nicholas Troyan
- D. HRFA Coordinator — Lieutenant Christopher Barkers**

The main idea here is how HRFA roles align with rank and day-to-day responsibilities. The HRFA Coordinator is focused on administrative duties—planning, scheduling, coordinating resources, and serving as the link between instructors and leadership. That kind of role fits a lieutenant well, since a lieutenant has enough authority to supervise staff and manage program operations without stepping into the higher-level duties of a director or the hands-on instructional leadership of a lead instructor. The other pairings place instructional leadership or executive oversight on ranks that don't align as cleanly with those duties: a lead instructor would carry primary instructional leadership and often require more experience or a higher position; an assistant instructor is typically a support role under a lead; a director is an executive-level position, not usually paired with a frontline firefighter/EMT rank. So the pairing of HRFA Coordinator with Lieutenant Christopher Barkers is the best fit.

**7. Which station's phone number is 441-1754?**

- A. Station 16**
- B. Station 14**
- C. Station 13 (Correct)**
- D. Station 15**

Matching a phone number to its station in the station directory is what this item tests. To answer, you'd locate the number 441-1754 in the directory where each station lists its own contact number, then read which station name sits beside it. In this case, 441-1754 is listed with Station 13, so that station is the one associated with that number. The other stations have different numbers, so they don't correspond to 441-1754. If you're studying, it helps to become familiar with the directory layout or memorize the pairings so you can quickly make this match on a test.

**8. Which station has the Small Tool Shop?**

- A. Station 11 - 3127 Verdun Ave**
- B. Station 8 - 526 Frederick St**
- C. Station 9 - 115 Thole St**
- D. Station 7 - 1211 W 43rd St**

The question tests how a facility feature is tied to its station. The Small Tool Shop is designated at Station 8, located at 526 Frederick St. That exact pairing identifies the correct location for the Small Tool Shop. The other stations and addresses correspond to different facilities, so they don't fit this specific designation.

**9. In the address 7924 \_\_\_\_\_ Road, what is the road name?**

- A. Camellia**
- B. Heath**
- C. Elm**
- D. Cobalt**

Reading an address is like number + street name + street type. The blank sits right before the word Road, so the word that goes there is the street name. Filling in Camellia gives Camellia Road, which is a valid road name in this format. The other options could also be road names in different places, but for this specific address the intended road name is Camellia.

**10. What street name completes the address 3127 \_\_\_\_\_ Ave?**

**A. Pembroke**

**B. Maple**

**C. Verdun**

**D. W Little Creek**

**This item tests recognizing a street name that actually exists as an Avenue in the local area. Verdun fits because Verdun Avenue is a real street in Norfolk, so the format 3127 Verdun Ave is a plausible address in that city. The other options don't align with the local street layout in the same way: W Little Creek is typically a road rather than an Avenue, and Pembroke or Maple are less likely to be the specific familiar Avenue corresponding to this address in the context of this test. So Verdun is the natural choice for completing the address.**
