By ensuring that a second form of verification is required, organizations can effectively safeguard not only individual user accounts but also the integrity of the entire Salesforce environment. The other options, although they contribute to overall security, do not provide the same level of direct protection against username and password compromise as two-factor authentication does. While IP ranges and trusted IPs help control access points and enhance security boundaries, they do not prevent the actual theft of credentials, which is the primary concern addressed by
