In contrast, other terms, such as malicious mischief, car tampering, or accidental activation, do not accurately reflect the primary purpose or significance of the tracking system's use in the context of stolen vehicle recovery. These scenarios involve different types of incidents rather than a direct indication of a vehicle being actively tracked for the purpose of recovery.
