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Explanations

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1. Which aircraft has a cargo capacity of 25,000 lbs?

Working in an enclosed space can also elevate noise levels, but it does not directly set the criteria for using single hearing protective devices without consideration of the decibel levels present.

This effectiveness at range underscores the adaptability and versatility of the M16A3E3 in various combat scenarios.
