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1. Rs. 41517 is distributed among A, B, and C in the ratio of 3:7:11. What is B's share?

Their components do not relate to agricultural practices or the systematic cultivation of crops, making them unsuitable in this context. Understanding the origin and implications of the word "creektulo" helps to appreciate its relevance to the concept of a plantation, enhancing comprehension of agricultural terminology.
