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1. Which statement reflects the listed purposes of SkillsUSA?

SkillsUSA aims to develop students beyond just technical skills by weaving in growth, character, and purpose. Each of the statements reflects a facet of that mission: cultivating enthusiasm for learning keeps students engaged and eager to grow; fostering a deep respect for the dignity of work emphasizes pride, ethics, and quality in what they do; helping students attain a purposeful life connects personal goals with service, integrity, and meaningful careers. Because all three align with the organization's aims, the choice that includes all of them is the best answer, as it acknowledges the full scope of SkillsUSA's purposes.

Negotiating contracts is typically handled by someone focused on agreements and procurement, not the financial planning role. Planning social events belongs to those concerned with programs and member engagement, often a events or activities chair. Writing press releases is a public relations task, usually led by the secretary or a PR officer. So assisting with the annual budget best fits the treasurer's responsibilities.

Your own actions determine whether you succeed or fail. You control how you prepare, how you respond to setbacks, and how you use feedback to improve. Tipping taxi drivers typically follows a standard practice: you give 15% to 20% of the fare, and if the driver handles your luggage you add 50 cents per bag. This range is widely regarded as fair for the level of service, balancing recognition for getting you where you're going with a reasonable amount. The flat per-bag fee is a separate supplement that applies regardless of the percentage tip. For example, with a \$12 fare and one bag, tipping 15% would be \$1.80 plus \$0.50 for the bag, totaling \$2.30. Tipping 20% would be \$2.40 plus \$0.50, totaling \$2.90. That illustrates why 15% to 20% is the best fit: it aligns with common tipping expectations while the bag fee adds a small, fixed extra.

Those other items may exist within the organization, but they're not what the Creed centers on.

When presenting portfolio content for employment, you want to show both what you can do and that others vouch for your abilities. Including a resume along with a letter of recommendation achieves that balance: the resume concisely communicates your background, skills, and accomplishments, while the letter of recommendation provides credible, third-party validation of your performance and character. This combination gives a clear, professional picture to employers. Personal photos are not usually appropriate in a work portfolio because they don't demonstrate qualifications and can introduce bias. A copy of academic transcripts alone also falls short, since it doesn't showcase your work products, specific achievements, or endorsements from others. So the strongest option is a resume plus a letter of recommendation, as it covers both your self-presentation and external support.
