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Explanations

1. 'Maquillarse' means what in English?

10. What is the English translation of 'saber'?

The correct English translation of 'saber' is 'to know.' In Spanish, 'saber' is a verb that is used to express knowledge of facts, information, or how to do something. It is important to be familiar with the different meanings of 'saber' and 'conocer' in Spanish, as they are both translated to 'to know' in English but are used in different contexts. In this case, 'to know' is the most appropriate translation for the verb 'saber.'
