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Explanations

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1. Limes PLU code?

- A. 4687
- B. 4048**
- C. 4727
- D. 4235

Limes are identified in the PLU (price look-up) system by a four-digit code. The standard code used for loose limes in many supermarkets is 4048, which is what cashiers use to pull the correct price at checkout. If the limes are organic, the code would be five digits starting with a 9, becoming 94048, to distinguish them from conventional limes. The other numbers correspond to different produce items, so they wouldn't match limes. So the lime PLU you're looking for is 4048.

2. Which item has PLU 4017?

- A. Apples Granny Smith**
- B. Grapes Red
- C. Banana
- D. Olive Bar

PLU codes help cashiers instantly identify the exact produce item and price. The four-digit code 4017 is the code assigned to Granny Smith apples, so this item matches that code. Other items like bananas, red grapes, or items from an olive bar have different PLU numbers, so they wouldn't be identified by 4017.

3. Which item has PLU code 4554?

- A. Cabbage red**

PLU codes are four-digit numbers that identify specific produce items so cashiers can price them quickly. The code 4554 is assigned to red cabbage, so scanning that number pulls up red cabbage's price in the store's system. Since it begins with a 4, it indicates conventional (not organic) produce, which fits how red cabbage is typically cataloged. The other items listed have different PLU numbers, so they would not be tied to 4554.

PLU codes are numeric identifiers used to specify a particular variety of produce at the point of sale. If the tomato were organic, you'd typically see a five-digit code starting with 9, such as 94087, used in many stores. The other numbers correspond to different items and do not identify the plum tomato, so 4087 is the correct code.

PLU codes are four-digit identifiers used at checkout to represent fresh produce. The first digit tells you it's conventional produce, and the remaining digits specify the exact item. The other numbers correspond to different produce items and won't register as Pepper Red.

PLU codes are numeric identifiers used at checkout to represent fresh produce so cashiers can price items quickly and consistently. Each item has its own code, and cantaloupe is assigned 4050. PLU codes are four-digit numbers supermarkets use to identify fresh produce at checkout, so the cashier can price and track the item accurately. Peach Eastern is assigned the code 4403, which is the specific identifier for that peach variety in the PLU system. That makes it the correct match for Peach Eastern. The other items point to different produce with their own codes, so they don't identify Peach Eastern.

9. PLU code 4081 is for which item?

PLU codes are four-digit numbers used at checkout to identify fresh produce and ensure consistent pricing. The code 4081 is assigned to eggplant in the standard Stop & Shop PLU list, so this item matches eggplant. Other produce items such as cucumber, russet potatoes, or plums have different PLU numbers, which is why they wouldn't be 4081.

10. Which PLU code is for Corn yellow?

PLU codes are the standardized numbers used at checkout to identify produce items. Yellow corn is assigned the four-digit PLU 4078, which is why this code is the right match. Four-digit codes indicate conventional farming, while organic items have a five-digit code starting with a 9 (for example, organic yellow corn would be 94078). The other numbers listed correspond to different produce items and do not designate yellow corn.
