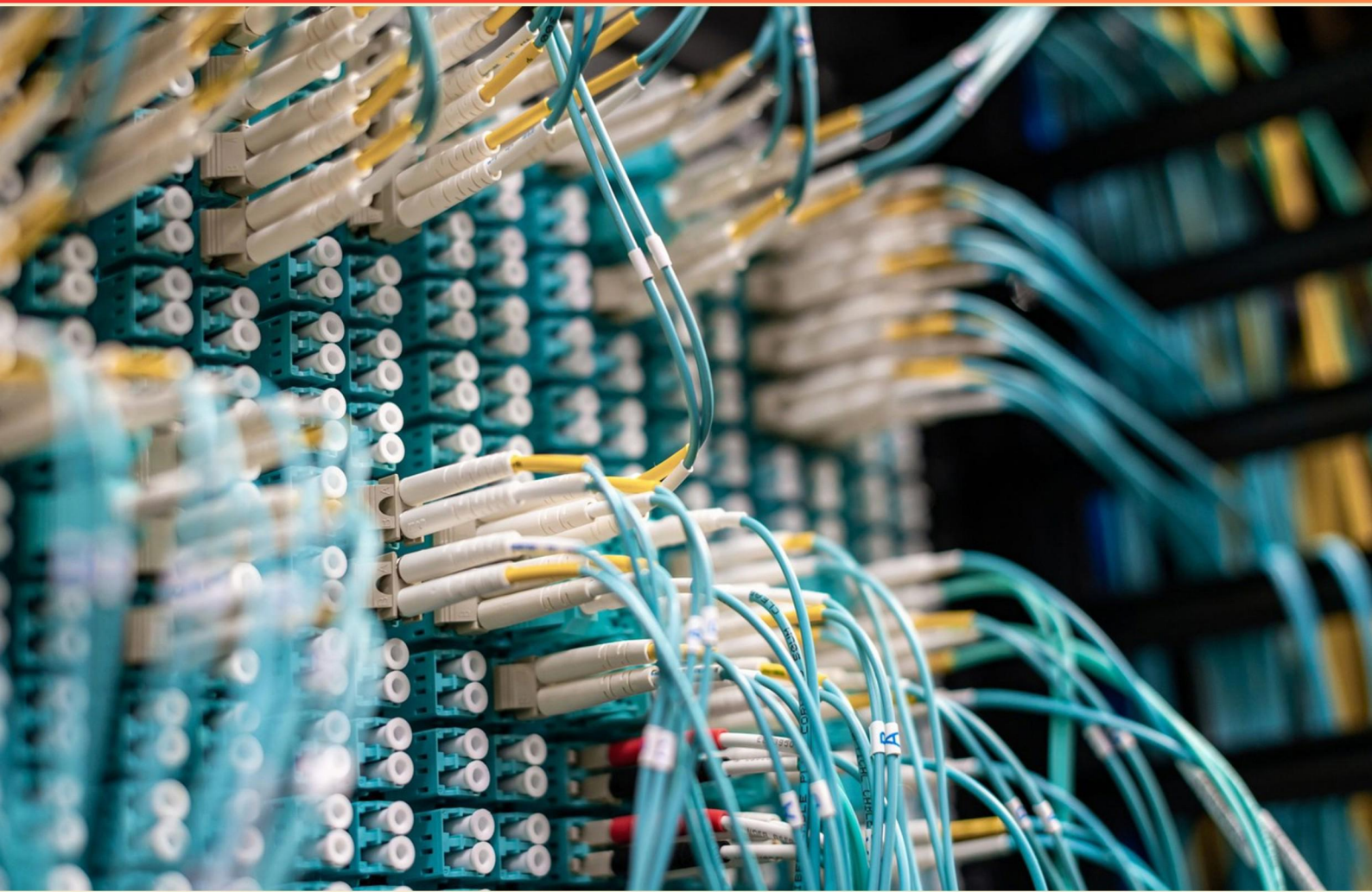

In contrast, linking the GPO only to the Temp OU, Support OU, or specifically to the Marketing and Sales OUs would limit the reach of the workstation settings to only those groups, possibly resulting in inconsistencies or the omission of critical configurations for other departments if they're not included. Therefore, linking the GPO at the domain level is the most effective strategy for comprehensive management of workstation settings across the organization.

Setting the original password to "asdf1234\$" is a proactive approach that helps in securing the user account right from its creation. It lays the groundwork for users to change it to something even more personalized and secure upon their first login, further reinforcing security practices.
