**1. What were they calling the dreamlessness when it first started?**

The main idea is how the community names and understands this sudden loss of dreams, framing it as a widespread crisis. When dreamlessness first appears, people describe it as a “plague of madness.” That phrasing matters because it conveys two things at once: a disease-like spread that affects many, and a psychological unraveling that feels frightening and out of control. It signals that dreaming has become dangerous or forbidden in their world, and people react with fear and urgency. Why this fits better than the other options: a wave of sleep would imply people are simply sleeping more, which doesn’t capture the sense of fear, contagion, or mental disruption; the silent slumber suggests peaceful, quiet sleep without the panic or societal impact; a curse of night hints at a supernatural force, which isn’t how the phenomenon is described—it’s treated as a widespread ailment spreading through communities.

The other names don’t fit because they would shift the emphasis to lakes alone, to rivers alone, or to a single catastrophic spill, rather than the broader struggle over water resources and contamination.

The situation centers on how power is exercised through control of a basic need. Water is treated as a scarce, carefully allocated resource at Four Winds Resort, and the narrative keeps returning to quotas, taps, and daily water shared among people. While other resources may appear in the story, water is the one that’s described as being systematically rationed to shape people’s lives, making it the best answer.

Because the text explicitly notes their rock-collecting behavior, rocks are what they collect. The other options don't fit this particular habit described in their scenes: shells and coins aren't described as their pastime, and bones are central to the world's premise but not what the twins collect themselves.

In this moment, the risk of discovery matters more than simple play. A lunch box with a fresh sandwich inside stands out as a problem because it signals food and a recent human presence. In a group trying to stay hidden, food can attract attention from others—whether trackers, scavengers, or animals—and it creates physical traces like smells and evidence that someone has been there. That makes carrying and playing with a lunch box much more dangerous than the other items, which are merely toys or tools that don't reveal such clear evidence of their location. The lunch box becomes a red flag that could lead to danger, so it's the best answer to explain why RiRi's toy idea caused worry.

8. What are the two groups the family splits into and took turns doing?

The main idea being tested is how the family organizes work to survive in a dangerous world. They divide tasks into two rotating roles: Hunters and Homesteaders. Hunters go out to find food, supplies, and other resources, using skill and vigilance in the wild. Homesteaders stay back at the camp to guard the group, prepare meals, mend gear, tend to the younger members, and keep the shelter and routine running smoothly. They take turns switching between these roles, which spreads the risk, prevents burnout, and ensures the camp remains fed and protected. This setup reflects a practical, collaborative approach to survival and highlights how the family relies on shared responsibilities. The other label pairings don't fit what the text describes, since the story centers on this specific division of labor between going out to hunt and staying to maintain the home base.

Staying calm in a dangerous encounter is the deciding factor. The other ideas don't fit because hunger, feeding, or being asleep don't reliably change the Rogarou's urge in the moment of contact—the fear response is what drives the outcome in these encounters.

Moving toward safety in the North is what drives the plan in *The Marrow Thieves*. The North is portrayed as a sanctuary in their world, a place they believe they can reach by staying on the northerly route and avoiding the more dangerous, southern settlements. So choosing north or northeast fits what the characters are aiming for: a safer, more secluded path to safety. The other directions would lead toward areas with greater danger or don't align with the path to the safe northern refuge the group intends to reach.
