1. The off-campus site managed by the Baskin School of Engineering with interdisciplinary research is which site?

- A. Coastal Science Campus**

Interdisciplinary collaboration in engineering thrives in dedicated off-campus hubs that bring together engineers, scientists from other fields, and external partners to work on shared projects. The Baskin School of Engineering's off-campus site designed for this kind of work is the Westside Research Park. It's set up to host cross-disciplinary teams and partnerships that extend beyond the main campus, making it the best fit for a facility focused on interdisciplinary engineering research. The Coastal Science Campus, by contrast, centers on coastal and environmental science; the UCSC Silicon Valley Campus and Bayside Innovation Center serve other missions such as industry partnerships or entrepreneurship.

2. Which college is paired with 'International and Global Perspectives'?

The question is testing your knowledge of how UCSC assigns a specific theme to each college. International and Global Perspectives is the theme paired with College 9, according to the campus pairing map used for these materials. This means College 9 is the college that emphasizes global and international viewpoints in its programs, events, and discussions, so that exact pairing is why it's considered the correct match. The other colleges have different theme pairings, so they don't align with this global perspective. If you're studying for this, it helps to memorize or reference the pairing map so you can quickly recall which college goes with which theme.

3. Which campus resource provides career resources and employment assistance?

Career centers are the go-to campus resource for career resources and employment help. They're designed to support you in exploring options, preparing for the job market, and connecting with employers. A Career Center typically offers career counseling, resume and cover letter reviews, interview coaching, internship and job postings, and opportunities like workshops and on-campus recruiting or job fairs. That combination directly targets finding employment and building a competitive profile, which is why it's the best choice here. Other campus units serve different purposes. SUA focuses on student life and services, CASFS is a research and education center about agroecology and sustainable food systems, and TAG addresses programs or initiatives not centered on general career resources.

4. Which nearby feature is correctly paired with its relative location from UCSC?

- A. Wilder Ranch State – West**
- B. Pogonip – West**
- C. Wilder Ranch State – East**
- D. Henry Cowell Redwoods – North**

Understanding relative location helps you orient where places sit in relation to UCSC. Wilder Ranch State Park sits along the coast to the west of the UCSC campus, so its correct pairing is its western position from UCSC. The other options place those features in directions that don't match their actual locations: Wilder Ranch to the east would contradict its coastal, west-of-campus position; Pogonip sits near UCSC but is north of the campus rather than west; and Henry Cowell Redwoods is farther inland to the north-east rather than simply north of UCSC.

5. Where can students go for 1-on-1 financial counseling services?

The main idea is to identify the campus resource that offers individualized financial guidance. SlugCents is the service on campus dedicated to personal finance help, providing one-on-one counseling to help students with budgeting, debt, and money planning. The other options don't focus on financial counseling: Cruz Care is about student health and wellbeing, Lick Observatory is an astronomy facility, and Merrill College is a residential college without a specific financial counseling program. For personalized financial guidance, SlugCents is the best fit.

6. Which off-campus site is associated with the Baskin School of Engineering?

- A. Coastal Science Campus**
- B. Westside Research Park**
- C. UCSC Silicon Valley Campus**

The main idea here is recognizing where Baskin School of Engineering operates its off-campus, specialized activities. The Westside Research Park is the off-campus site associated with Baskin, serving as a hub for engineering research, labs, and collaborations with industry. It provides space for hands-on projects, prototypes, and partnerships that extend the engineering program beyond the main campus. The Coastal Science Campus focuses on marine and environmental science, the UCSC Silicon Valley Campus hosts other UCSC programs in Silicon Valley, and the Santa Cruz Engineering Center is not the designated off-campus Baskin site. So, the Westside Research Park is the correct association.

7. ACE stands for which program?

- A. Academic Excellence Program**

Acronyms like ACE are created by taking the initials of the main words in a program name, usually skipping short connecting words like for, of, or the. So ACE usually comes from three content words starting with A, C, and E. Among the options, there are plausible three-word titles that fit that pattern when you ignore a small word like “for”: Advanced Curriculum for Educators, Alliance for Community Education, and Academic Criteria Evaluation. The choice Academic Excellence Program doesn’t map to ACE in a straightforward way (it would give A-E-P), so the exact intended mapping depends on the official program title used by the organization. In practice, when you see ACE, look for a three-word name whose main words start with A, C, and E.

8. Which college is paired with 'Social Justice and Community'?

- A. John R. Lewis College**
- B. Oakes College**

Social justice and community are the guiding focus for a UCSC college identity. John R. Lewis College is the one built around those ideals, named for civil rights leader John Lewis, and its programs emphasize inclusion, service, and civic engagement. That direct alignment is why it’s the best match for the theme. The other colleges have different thematic emphases, so they don’t fit this pairing.

9. Do UCSC summer courses include online options?

- A. Yes**
- B. No**
- C. Only online**
- D. Only in-person**

Online options are available for UCSC summer courses. Summer sessions typically include online courses in addition to in-person ones, giving you flexibility to study remotely if that fits your schedule or location. The correct choice reflects that there are online formats, while not implying that every course is online or that only online formats exist. If you want to know exactly which courses are online this term, check the Summer Sessions catalog for that term, since modality can vary by course.

10. What is the open natural space to the east of campus managed by the city?

A. Pogonip

B. El Sereno Open Space

C. Sanborn County Park

D. Arboretum Trail

Pogonip is the open natural space just east of the UCSC campus that is managed by the city. It's a sizable, city-owned natural area with trails and habitat for wildlife, maintained by the Santa Cruz Parks and Recreation Department, making it the appropriate match for a city-managed space located to the east of campus. The other spaces are not the city-managed open space adjacent to the campus: they are either different parks or areas associated with other managing bodies, or not located in that east-of-campus context.
