Manually starting the process every time defeats the purpose of automation and scheduling by requiring constant human involvement. Editing the XML of the workflow is a technical process that does not pertain to scheduling; it is primarily related to modifying the structure of the workflow itself rather than determining when it should run. Thus, creating a trigger is the most efficient and effective way to automate the scheduling of processes in UiPath Orchestrator.

Robot settings focus more on the execution environment and configurations related to the robot but do not provide logging level adjustments. The Orchestrator reporting section is concerned with monitoring and managing robots, rather than configuring logging within Studio. The Workflow Analyzer tool is designed for analyzing workflows against best practices and does not offer direct configurations for logging levels.
