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Explanations

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1. Who is the Washington HOSA's Chair Member?

A. Cheryl T. Reed

B. Brad Collins

C. Jami Wollan

This question asks you to identify who holds the chair leadership role in Washington HOSA. The chair member is the person who presides over meetings, helps set agendas, and coordinates state-level activities for HOSA. Cheryl T. Reed is the one listed in official Washington HOSA officer rosters as the Chair Member, which is why she is the correct answer. The other individuals may hold different roles within the organization, but they are not listed as the chair. If you want to verify, you can check the official Washington HOSA site or the latest SLC program/roster where current officers are named.

2. Who is the International President Elect?

A. Jeet Sridhar - South Carolina

B. Ria Mohan - Virginia

C. Shriya Kunam - Georgia

D. Matthew Kim - California

The International President Elect is the member who will become the International President in the next term, preparing to lead the organization after the current president's term ends. According to the official roster, Jeet Sridhar from South Carolina holds that role, so he is the International President Elect. This means he will work with the current International President, help set upcoming goals, and lead the officer team during the transition. The other names listed are different leaders from other states and do not hold the presidency-elect title at this time.

3. Who is the Director of HOSA Washington Office?

A. George Sifakis

This question is about who leads HOSA's Washington Office, the team responsible for federal outreach and government relations on behalf of the organization and its members. The person who holds that role is George Sifakis. He directs the office, coordinating with lawmakers, shaping HOSA's federal advocacy priorities, and helping chapters understand how policy affects health-occupations education and student opportunities. That leadership position is identified in official HOSA materials and bios, which is why this name is the best fit for the director. The other individuals are associated with different roles or contexts within HOSA and are not listed as the Washington Office director in those official sources.

4. The National Executive Council refers to which group?

The National Executive Council is the national leadership's executive arm at the top level. It consists of the organization's elected officers who run day-to-day operations, make policy decisions, and oversee programs and finances between member meetings. That's why it's best understood as the national executive team—the group actively steering the national organization. Regional councils are the subnational bodies, the advisory board typically offers guidance without running operations, and while some contexts use "governing body," this term doesn't specifically capture the active executive leadership at the national level in this organization.

5. Which of the following items is included in standard meeting minutes?

Standard meeting minutes are a formal record of what happened at a meeting, so they include the key details that establish what, when, and who was involved. Recording the date and time provides a precise timestamp for the meeting, which helps verify when decisions were made. Listing attendees shows who was present and who participated in discussions and votes. Note the time of adjournment documents when the meeting concluded, indicating the duration and the formal end of proceedings. Together, these elements ensure the minutes are a complete and usable record, which is why all of these items are commonly included.

6. Who is the Secondary Board Representative?

The position of Secondary Board Representative is the backup member on the Board of Representatives, assigned to a specific state. In the current official roster, that spot is filled by David Gonzalez from Texas, so his name matches the role. The other names are linked to different states or duties, so they don't fit this specific position.

7. Who is the Deputy Director International Competitive Events?

- A. Dana Chandler

This asks you to know who holds the Deputy Director International Competitive Events, a leadership role responsible for supporting and coordinating the organization's international competitive activities. The Deputy Director serves as the second-in-command to the Director, helping manage planning, scheduling, and ensuring rules and guidelines are followed so events run smoothly across chapters and regions. Dana Chandler is listed in this deputy role, which is why she is the best answer. The other names are associated with different positions or duties and do not occupy this particular deputy title. Knowing who sits in this role helps you understand who oversees the overall direction and execution of international competitive events.

8. Which individual is associated with New Jersey?

- A. Megan Lloren - New Jersey
- B. Gowthamm Mandala - Indiana

This question tests your ability to read and connect each person with the state listed next to their name. The only person explicitly linked to New Jersey is Megan Lloren. The others are paired with different states (Indiana and Washington), or have no state listed. Because the state association must be the exact one shown, Megan Lloren is the correct match for New Jersey. In these items, rely on the explicit pairing given rather than guessing.

9. Which creed line emphasizes the importance of academic excellence, skills, training, and leadership development in the career pathway?

- A. I understand the importance of academic excellence, skills, training, and leadership development in my career pathway.
- B. I recognize the universal need for quality compassionate healthcare.
- C. I believe through my service to my community and to the world, I will make the best use of my knowledge and talents.
- D. I accept the responsibility of a health care professional and seek to find my place on a team equally committed to the wellbeing of others.

The line that emphasizes academic excellence, skills, training, and leadership development in my career pathway directly ties growth and preparation to the future profession. It signals a commitment to advancing knowledge and leadership as integral parts of pursuing a health care career, which is exactly what the question is asking about. The other lines focus on broader themes like delivering quality compassionate health care, serving the community or the world, or taking on teamwork and professional responsibility. While those are important values, they don't specifically highlight developing through education and leadership as part of a career path, so they're not addressing the prompt as precisely.

10. Which surname corresponds to the Director International Competitive Events?

A. Mould

B. Koeninger

C. Staub

D. Burley

This item tests your ability to recall which person holds a specific officer title in the official WAHOSA SLC roster. The Director International Competitive Events is a leadership role responsible for overseeing competitive events with an international scope. In the official roster, that role is held by the person with the surname Mould, making it the correct match. The other surnames belong to different officers, so they don't fit the assignment for this director. Knowing the roster helps you quickly connect titles to the people who fill them, so Mould is the correct surname for this position.
