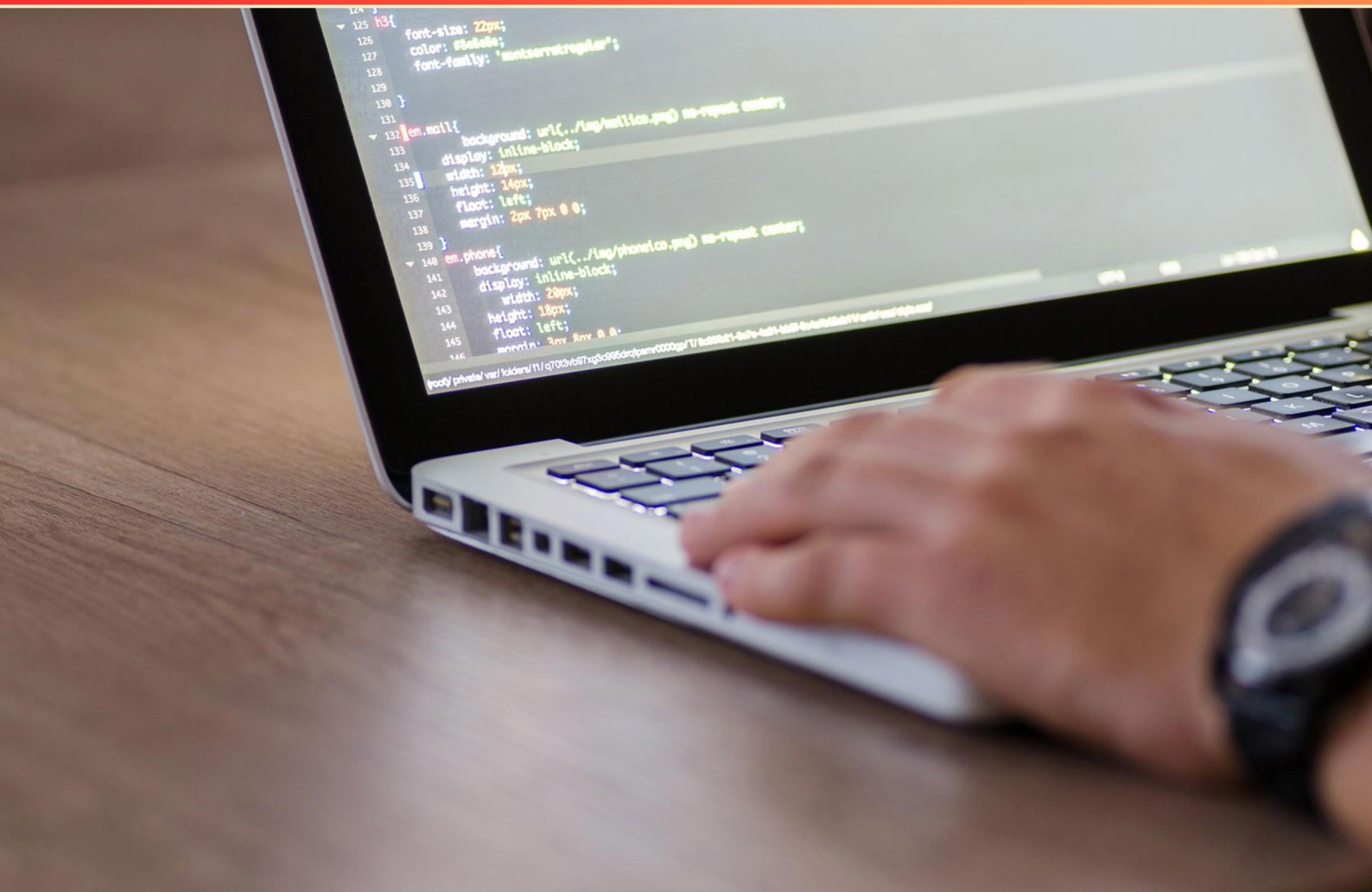

CORS, or Cross-Origin Resource Sharing, is a security feature implemented by browsers to control how web applications can request resources from different origins.
